## Johnny Appleseed Street Tree Project

The Johnny Appleseed Street Tree Project began in 1976 in an effort to support the City of Oakwood's commitment to urban forestry and the environment. To date, this program has been responsible for planting over 2,600 trees. Below are the highlights of the program:

- \* Cost of the selected species are discounted 50% to Oakwood residents. Trees must be planted in the city right-of-way.
- \* Species of trees will be 1 3/4" in diameter and are excellent for planting.
- \* The most needy areas of Oakwood, as determined by the City of Oakwood, will be given first priority.
- \* One tree will be allocated at the 50% discount for each approved property site.
- \* Tree specie selections are well suited for planting and most are resistant to disease.
- \* The tree will be guaranteed for one growing season by the nursery who plants it.

Applications are available at the Oakwood Community Center during business hours, Monday through Sunday. Once the application has been completed, please return it along with your payment to the Oakwood Community Center or mail the application to the:

### Tree Characteristics:

Mature Height: 40' - 50'

Rate of Growth: Medium

Shape: Oval

Leaves: Red to maroon

Fruit: Samaras

Flowers: Greenish, yellow

Comments: A very tolerant street tree, no serious pest problems, beautiful red to maroon leaves throughout the season.

**Tree Characteristics:**

Mature Height: 60' - 75'  
Rate of Growth: Medium  
Shape: Upright-oval  
Leaves: Medium to Dark Green  
Fall Color: Yellow, orange and red  
Flowers: Insignificant flowers that emerge before leaf set.  
Fruit: Samaras  
Comments: Excellent shade tree for lawn, large areas and street trees.

**Tree Characteristics:**

Mature Height: 25' - 35'  
Rate of Growth: Medium to fast  
Shape: Upright, vase-shaped  
Leaves: Green to dark green  
Fall Color: Maroon  
Fruit: 1/3" disc, green turning to tan in the fall  
Comments: High urban and stress tolerance; resistant to insect and disease problems of elms.

**Tree Characteristics:**

Mature Height: 25'  
Rate of Growth: Medium  
Shape: Upright and oval  
Leaves: Medium to dark green  
Fall Color: Faded green to chartreuse brown  
Flowers: Creamy white inflorescences in early June  
Comments: Virtually disease and pest free ornamental tree.

**Tree Characteristics:**

Mature Height: Generally over 70'  
Rate of Growth: Medium  
Shape: Upright and rounded, broadens with age  
Leaves: Dark, glossy green  
Fall Color: Bright red to dull red  
Fruit: Acorns  
Comments: An attractive residential tree; no serious disease problems; higher water requirements necessary for establishment.
